- Horse accommodation is available at the grounds, but covered stalls are limited to 50
- Stalls will be allocated and you will be advised of your box/covered stall number - please keep you requests for covered accommodation to a minimum. **NO LOOSE BOXES OR COVERED STALLS WILL BE ALLOCATED TO PONIES.**
- Loose Boxes & Covered Stalls - \$12.00 per night
- Uncovered Yards - \$12.00 for entire Show.
- Ground Levy - \$5.00 per horse/pony
- Prize Money will be paid out at the Show.
- The Stewards retain the right to change the order of, alter or delete classes dependant on entries
- Refund rules - 80% of entry fees will be refunded if the scratching is accompanied by a Vet certificate. All other refunds are 50%. Refunds will be mailed to competitors after the Show

- * The horse/pony is considered to have started its first year on the day it gains its initial point and may remain in First Year Registration for 365 days starting on that date and thereafter it becomes open.
- * Under the new Showhunter rules, ponies may enter any height class, except in the High Points Class where pony heights apply.
- * For classes with under 8 entries only 1st and 2nd prize money will be paid, and with under 6 entries only 1st prize paid.
