BEEF CATTLE

Classes for pure bred animals registered with a Breed Society recognised by the Royal Agricultural Society and for other beef breeds and graded cross bred beef breeds entered under Lifestyle Classes.

Animals may be entered in either Pure bred Beef or Lifestyle classes but not both

TO BE JUDGED ON SATURDAY JANUARY 22nd 2022 AT 9.30AM

NAIT: A NAIT approved RFID tag will be mandatory on all animals. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to record all animal movements with NAIT prior to leaving the farm/property for the Show and then within 48 hours of returning to the farm/property from the Show.

The Horowhenua AP & I NAIT number is 443562.

TB TESTING RAS RULES:

1. All animals entered for showing or exhibiting must be from a current TB Clear Status Herd.
2. All animals entered for showing must be from a herd that is current with its TB testing Requirements.
3. The Association must be notified, within 48 hours, of any TB testing that results in potential TB issues being identified after entries have been submitted. This will include TB testing of animals associated with those entered for showing. Owners entering cattle must sign any declaration printed on the entry form.
4. All animals entered that originate from a movement control area, must be notified at the time of entry. These animals, if aged 90 days or older, must complete a clear pre-movement TB test within 60 days of their movement to the show.

GENERAL RULES:

All Bulls yearling and over **MUST** be led with a halter and permanent nose ring with lead

All females yearling and over **MUST** be led with a halter and a nose clip with lead.

All animals must be NAIT tagged which will be read on the grounds and be accompanied by an ASD form. NAIT compliance for movement to and from the show is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

RFID numbers must be entered on the entry form or entries will not be accepted.

RAS AFFILIATED CLASSES FOR REGISTERED BEEF BREEDS

HIGHLAND cattle in this class must have an RAS issued passport number. Entries received without a passport will be moved to Lifestyle classes.

ENTRY FEE: \$10 all classes unless otherwise stated

Entry fees must accompany entry and RFID numbers must be entered in full or entries will be declined.

GROUP CLASSES

Open to all animals from either section

293. BREED GROUP of at least 3 animals including at least 1 male, need not be the same owner – a fun class representing your breed, dress up if you like! (no entry fee) ribbons only
294. PAIR OF ANIMALS any age, any sex, to be judged as a pair.
295. YOUNG HANDLERS aged 18 years and under- no entry fee -ribbons only
296. STEER, Calf or Yearling – suitable for Future Beef led steer, all breeds and cross breeds eligible.
