1. Entry Fee \$10
2. Points to count for Shield – 1st 10, 2nd 6, 3rd 4, VHC 2
3. Space of Bay – Approx: Frontage 1740m, 870mm deep, 900mm high
4. All work to be judged to be entirely the work of members
5. Accessories and props allowed.
6. Exhibits are to be set up on Friday morning, 21st January, **9.00-10.30am**
No further time will be permitted
7. Only **3** members responsible for arranging the court will be admitted on the Friday and **2** on the **Sunday at 4.30 pm**
8. The position of the Court will be allocated by ballot.
9. Competitive exhibits to be numbered as per schedule.
10. No packet cake mixes to be used.
11. Judging: (a) Quality and finish 100
(b) Arrangement and display 80
