- 3. Space of Bay Approx: Frontage 174cm, 85cm deep, 90cm high
- 4. All work to be judged to be entirely the work of members
- 5. Accessories and props allowed.
- 6. Exhibits are to be set up on Friday morning, 16<sup>th</sup> January, **8.30-10.am No further time will be permitted**
- Only 3 members responsible for arranging the court will be admitted on the Friday and 2 on the <u>Sunday at 5.30 pm</u>
- 8. The position of the Court will be allocated by ballot.
- 9. Competitive exhibits to be numbered as per schedule.
- 10. No packet cake mixes to be used.
- 11.Judging: (a) Quality and finish100(b) Arrangement and display80180
