

# NAIT NUMBER 443562.

Classes for pure bred animals registered with a Breed Society recognised by the Royal Agricultural Society entering in either Beef or Lifestyle Classes. Animals may be entered in either Purebred Beef or Speciality Beef classes but not both.

TO BE JUDGED ON SATURDAY JANUARY 17th 2026 AT 9.30AM

#### **TB Testing - Ospri Definition and Requirements**

- 1. All animals entered for showing or exhibiting must be from a current TB Clear Status Herd.
- 2. All animals entered for showing must be from a herd that is current with its TB testing Requirements.
- 3. The Association must be notified, within 48 hours, of any TB testing that results in potential TB issues being identified after entries have been submitted. This will include TB testing of animals associated with those entered for showing. Owners entering cattle must sign any declaration printed on the entry form.
- 4. All animals entered that originate from a movement control area, must be notified at the time of entry. These animals, if aged 90 days or older, must complete a clear pre-movement TB test within 60 days of their movement to the show.
- 5. Exhibitors must bring a copy of AHB form for collection upon arrival

### **Nait Compliance Definition and Requirements**

# All stock must be NAIT registered and in accordance with OSPRI and TBfree New Zealand. Regardless of age they must be

- Departing from a property that is registered with a NAIT number and TBfree NZ herd number accompanied with a copy of a valid Animal Status Declaration form.
- Fitted with a valid NAIT RFID tag and registered in the NAIT system.
- Registered in a movement to the event NAIT number (443562) from the animal's current NAIT number no later than Friday 16<sup>th</sup> January. Please bring a copy of your Nait transfer with you.
- Registered in a return movement from the event NAIT number to their destination (receiving NAIT number) within 48 hours of departure.
- All stock over 90 days of age travelling from within a TBfree Movement Control Area must be premovement tested within 60 days of arriving at the event.
- All TBfree forms and Nait transfers will be collected upon arrival and animals Nait tag Scanned on the transport (Please do not unload your animals from transport until a Steward has electronically recorded their Nait RFID number and you have then been directed to do so).
- In accordance with MPI regulations the Levin AP&I Show operates a policy of No Nait, No Show, No exceptions
- All entries must include Nait RFID numbers specific to each individual animal entered (how to find your RFID number(s) is shown below).

#### **General Rules**

- All Bulls 12 months and over MUST be led with a halter and permanent nose ring with lead
- ALL Senior Bulls 2 years and over must also be led by 2 leaders
- All females yearling and over MUST be led with a halter and a nose clip with lead.
- HIGHLAND cattle entries must have an RAS issued passport number.
- A minimum 2-meter gap must be maintained between studs at all times
- Washbays must be kept clean at all times
- ALL ANIMALS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER





#### **HOW TO FIND YOUR RFID NUMBERS**

To find EACH individual animals RFID number you must already have the animal registered in the NAIT system. You then need to log on to your NAIT and click on "registered animals" as below



The RFID number is then showing in the second column as below and is individual to each animal. Please ensure you have the correct one.
